

What are the average stats for accepted dental students?

The stats for dental schools vary greatly with average GPAs ranging from about 3.1 up to nearly 3.8 while the DAT scores range from 16 to 24. The average GPA and DAT statistics change year by year and have been steadily increasing over the last decade. While seven years ago the average dental school had entrance statistics of about a 3.2 or 3.3 and a 17 DAT score, the average has now climbed to a 3.5 GPA with a DAT Academic Average (AA) of slightly above 19. The below chart shows the average statistics for dental students who entered dental school in 2006.
